

RESOLUTION OF THE  
NAVAJO BOARD OF ELECTION SUPERVISORS

**Extending Filing Deadline for the Vacant Elective Position for Farm Board Member,  
Rock Point Chapter, starting September 23, 2022, 8:00 A.M. and  
ending October 06, 2022, 5:00 P.M.**

**WHEREAS:**


1. The Navajo Board of Election Supervisors of the Navajo Nation implements and enforces the Navajo Nation Election Code; 11 N.N.C. Section 321(A); pursuant to this responsibility, the Board has the authority to ensure the fair and proper implementation of all provisions of the Code.
2. Pursuant to 11 N.N.C. §28 of the Navajo Election Code provides that *“(i)f no candidate has filed within the time period required for filing under this Code, the Board may extend the time for such period as it deems appropriate.”*
3. There remains a vacant elective position within the Northern Agency for Farm Board Member, Rock Point Chapter. As no one has filed for the position, a filing extension must be provided. See attached **Exhibit “A.”**
4. It is necessary and in the best interest of the Navajo Nation that filing periods be extended for current vacant position.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The Navajo Board of Election Supervisors hereby extends the filing deadline for the vacant elective position for Farm Board Member, Rock Point Chapter, which no candidates have filed. See attached **Exhibit “A.”** This extension shall run from 8:00 A.M. on September 23, 2022 to 5:00 P.M. on October 06, 2022.
2. This extension of filing date shall not be applicable for any position for which a qualified candidate files within the original filing date and time.

**CERTIFICATION**
