

Qualifications for Navajo Nation Board of Education

11 N.N.C. §§ 8 (D)(5); (E); (F)(1); 203 (C)

1. All candidates shall be enrolled members of the Navajo Nation.
2. All candidates shall be at least twenty-five (25) years of age at the time of filing.
3. All candidates shall not be delegates to the Navajo Nation Council, shall not be a member of a school board of a school operating on the Navajo Nation, shall not be an employee of the Department of Diné Education.
4. All candidates shall have at least a four-year academic degree from an accredited college or university.
5. All candidates shall not have been convicted of a felony or of any crime involving child abuse or neglect.
6. Shall maintain all qualifications during their term of elected office.
7. Shall not be certified as qualified for any public elective office of the Navajo Nation if he or she has not completely satisfied or otherwise has failed to fully comply with any order of any entity, including administrative hearing bodies and courts of the Navajo Nation, authorized to impose sanctions or penalties for violations of the Navajo Nation Ethics in Government Law.
8. Must not be ineligible for elective office pursuant to provisions of Navajo Nation Election Code addressing failure to file a Campaign Expense Statement pursuant to 11 N.N.C. § 203 (C).
